## Savills Am Law 100 Return-To-Office Survey Results

## ~90% of Am Law 100 firms responded they are encouraging or mandating a set number of days in the office, with most firms encouraging or mandating 3 days per week

**96% of firms** responded they are implementing return-to-office policies on a firmwide basis, with **41%** mandating attendance.

Notes: (1) Firms are encouraging attendance firmwide but have no set number of days per week. (2) "Strongly encouraged" in gateway markets (top law firm markets); mandating 3 days per week in other markets.

## **Key Takeaways**

Nearly a third of Am Law 100 firms responded to our Return-To-Office Survey, with ~90% of Am Law 100 firms responding they are encouraging or mandating a set number of days per week in the office.



## 96% of firms

responded they are implementing return-to-office firmwide rather than on an office-by-office basis.



**67%** of firms responded that they are encouraging or mandating their attorneys to come to the office **3 days per week.** 

Compliance with return-to-office policies varied between firms and by market.



Some firms reported anecdotally that they are seeing more compliance when return-to-office policies are mandated compared to when policies are encouraged.



Many firms mentioned they **implemented anchor days** (i.e., days that every team member comes into the workplace) to support hybrid work. Tuesday and Wednesday are the most common anchor days.

Several firms noted that support staff is in the office more days per week than attorneys (often 4 days per week).

We see firms becoming increasingly prescriptive in when and how often they expect their attorneys to be in the office: Of the firms that implemented mandated return-to-office policies, one firm noted they are considering mandating Monday (in addition to mandating Tuesday through Thursday).
