- Announced by the NYCEDC. LifeSci NYC is a \$1 billion initiative to grow life sciences in New York while adding 40,000 jobs and over 1.5 million square feet (msf) of academic, public health, and lab by 2031.
- The Chan Zuckerberg Initiative (CZI) announced the launch of a new biomedical research hub that aims to detect and monitor cell disease before it becomes untreatable.

Mayor Adams signed a bill renewing tax credits for biotechnology companies, which can be used to offset business taxes and attract life sciences companies to New York.


